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COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 5C (ANC-5C) and the undersigned Alcohol Beverage Control (ABC) licensed establishment pledge to work cooperatively: ANC-5C will support the ABC license renewals of establishments which actively participate in fulfilling the terms of this agreement, and the ABC licensed establishment will participate with ANC-5C to the best of its ability to improve the overall environment in order to make and keep our area a clean, safe and productive place for both residents and customers. Parties to this agreement will also take the following measures:

ANC PLEDGES TO:

1. Work toward an enhanced police presence in the 5C area for the purpose of ensuring safety and order for businesses and customers alike.
2. Work with the DC Department of Public Works to improve street and alley cleaning services and maintenance of a clean environment.
3. Work closely with all business associations/professional groups to assist businesses in the 5C area.
4. Work closely and cooperatively with the beautification efforts of businessmen in the 5C area.
5. Develop and provide display signs to identify all ABC licensed establishments which are signatories to this agreement.
6. Work to secure funding and staffing for alcohol and drug treatment programs in the 5C area.

BLOOMINGDALE-EDGEWOOD-SHAW (ANC-5C)

ABC LICENSED ESTABLISHMENT PLEDGES TO:

1. Not sell or deliver alcoholic beverages to any person who is inebriated.
2. Not sell or deliver alcoholic beverages to any person or persons under the age of 21.
3. Take all precautions to avoid the sale or delivery of alcoholic beverages to anyone accompanying a person who has been denied service if there is an apparent attempt to deliver the alcoholic beverage to the person who has been denied service.
4. Not provide "go-cups" to customers. A "go-cup" is defined in Section 709.7 of the ABC Regulations as a "drinking utensil provided at no charge or a nominal charge to a customer for the purpose of consuming alcoholic beverages."
5. Take a reasonable measure to ensure that the immediate environs of Walter Johnson's Liquor Store are kept free of litter and debris. "Immediate environs" is defined in Section 720.2 of the ABC Regulations as including: "all property on which the premises are located; all property used by the licensee to conduct its business, whether part of the premises or not, including parking lots and the portion of alleys, sidewalks, or other public property immediately adjacent to the premises or adjacent to the property used by the licensee to conduct its business."
6. (Class A and B establishments only) To discourage the opening of or the consumption of alcoholic beverages in the immediate environs of Walter Johnson's Liquor Store. The term "immediate environs" is as defined in Item 5 above.
